Department (EED)

Since 2004, San Francisco's Preschool for All (PFA) program has supported reduced-cost and free preschool access for San Francisco County 4-year-old children, regardless of family income, ethnicity, or background.

OECE's investments in PFA allow SFUSD EED to operate 76 Pre-kindergarten classes for both general education and special education students, provide professional development and instructional coaching support to PFA staff, as well as implementing and administering the Quality Rating and Improvement System (QRIS). In addition, SFUSD EED collaborates with community based organizations and other SFUSD departments to support transition into kindergarten for families in SFUSD EED and community based preschools.

The Preschool for All program with SFUSD is specific to their EED classrooms. No other early care and education program performs these duties within the SFUSD system. A fair amount of early childhood education is conducted at the public school facilities where SFUSD is the sole agency operating.

SFUSD has been providing these services for San Francisco since 2013. We are asking for an extension of the sole source waiver granted in 2016 to extend the grant to June 30, 2021.
