11	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
12	
13	Section 1. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding Section 10.100-118,
14	to read as follows:
15	SEC. 10.100-118. MAYOR'S NUISANCE ABATEMENT REVOLVING LOAN FUND.
16	(a) Establishment of Fund. The Mayor's Nuisance Abatement Revolving Loan Fund is
17	established as a category four fund to receive any legally available monies appropriated for this
18	purpose. The monies to be deposited in the fund shall include, subject to any prior legally-binding
19	obligations, principal repayments of loans made from the fund and fees and interest earnings generated
20	by loans made from the Fund.
21	(b) Use of Fund. Expenditures from the fund shall be for the following purposes: (1) to provide
22	loans to building owners to make repairs and improvements needed to abate Municipal Code
23	violations; and (2) to pay for expenses incurred in the administration of such loans. Administrative
24	expenses shall be appropriated through the annual budget process or supplemental appropriation for
25	the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development ("MOHCD"), or its successor.

1	(c) Administration of Fund. MOHCD shall administer loan programs under the fund, and in
2	such capacity shall: (1) service loan agreements; (2) receive payments for, and maintain current
3	accounts of principal, interest, and fees relating to the loan agreements, and redeposit them into the
4	fund; and, (3) allocate funds for administration associated with the operation of the fund, such funds
5	being limited to interest earnings generated by loans, collection of fees and the proceeds of investments
6	of unexpended cash balances from the fund.
7	MOHCD shall report annually to the Board of Supervisors on the current status of the fund, the
8	amounts approved for disbursement, and the number and types of projects assisted.
9	The Director of MOHCD may, after a noticed public hearing, adopt rules and regulations for
10	the loan program or programs and for the administration of the fund.
11	
12	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
13	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
14	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
15	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
