Resolution approving designation of four selling spaces on the north side of Market Street, Drumm to Spear Streets, for use by street artists certified by the Arts Commission of the City and County of San Francisco; and exempting said spaces from the regulations of Police Code, Section 2405, relating to street artist display size, distance from entrances, distance from crosswalks, and distance between artists' displays.

[Street Artist Spaces - Market Street, Drumm to Spear Streets]

WHEREAS, The Street Artists Ordinance adopted by the voters of San Francisco as Proposition "L" at the election held on November 4, 1975, authorizes the Board of Supervisors, by resolution, to designate sales areas where any street artist or craftsperson previously certified may sell art or craft items; and

WHEREAS, The Arts Commission on December 7, 2015, unanimously voted to request the Board of Supervisors for designation of four (4) spaces on the north side of Market Street, Drumm to Steuart streets, for street artists; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the following selling spaces are hereby designated for street artists certified by the Arts Commission:

Spaces:

4 – Market Street, north side, Drumm to Spear streets; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the four (4) spaces hereby designated on Market Street, north side, Drumm to Spear streets, are exempt from the provisions of Police Code, Sections 2405(c)(1), (c)(2), (c)(3), and (c)(4), which prohibit street artists from selling, offering for sale or soliciting offers to purchase on any sidewalk in an area more than four and one-half (4 ½)

feet from the curb line of any sidewalk, more than five (5) feet above any sidewalk, and more than four (4) feet long; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the displays of street artists selling, offering for sale or soliciting offers to purchase in the four (4) spaces on Market Street, north side, Drumm to Spear streets, shall be not more than twenty-nine (29) feet from the curb line of the sidewalk, not within nineteen (19) feet of the curb line of the sidewalk, not more than seven (7) feet above the sidewalk, and not more than ten (10) feet long; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That one (1) of the four (4) spaces on Market Street, north side, Drumm to Spear streets, is hereby exempt from the provision of Police Code, Section 2405(c)(6), which prohibits street artists from selling within ten (10) feet of the outer edge of any entrance to any building, but not limited to doors, driveways, emergency exits, measured in each direction parallel to the building line and thence at a 90-degree angle to the curb; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That two (2) of the four (4) spaces on Market Street, north side, Drumm to Spear streets, are hereby exempt from the provision of Police Code, Section 2405(c)(9), which prohibits street artists from selling within five (5) feet of any crosswalk; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That said spaces are hereby exempt from the provision of Police Code, Section 2405(c)(11), which prohibits a street artist from selling within five (5) feet of the display of any other artist.
