Should the proposed charter amendment be approved by the voters, in my opinion, it would significantly increase the cost of government.

The proposed amendment would transfer responsibility for the maintenance of all street trees to the City on July 1, 2017. The City's Department of Public Works estimates the additional annual maintenance cost for trees subject to the ordinance at \$13.1 million in fiscal year 2017-18, although the actual cost of the program would be subject to approval of the Mayor and Board of Supervisor in the annual budget process.
