Section 1. The Board of Supervisors hereby submits to the qualified voters of the City and County, at an election to be held on November 8, 2016, a proposal to amend the Charter of the City and County by revising Section 8.100 and adding Section 13.111, to read as follows:

SEC. 8.100. UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT.

The Unified School District shall be under the control and management of a Board of Education composed of seven members who shall be elected pursuant to Section 13.111by the voters of the Unified School District. A student representative shall serve on the Board in accordance with state law. No member of this Board shall be eligible to serve on the Governing Board of the Community College District. The compensation for each member shall be \$500 per month. The terms of office in effect for Board members on the date this Charter is adopted shall continue.

[Charter Amendment - Non-Citizen Voting in School Board Elections]

Describing and setting forth a proposal to the voters, at an election to be held on November 8, 2016, to amend the Charter of the City and County of San Francisco to authorize San Francisco residents who are not United States citizens but who are the parents, legal guardians, or caregivers of a child residing in San Francisco to vote in elections for the Board of Education.

Existing Law

San Francisco residents who are 18 years of age or older, United States citizens, and not in prison or on parole for a felony conviction are eligible to register to vote in San Francisco elections, including elections for the Board of Education of the San Francisco Unified School District. Non-citizens are not eligible to register to vote.

Amendments to Current Law

If approved by the voters, this Charter amendment would:

- Authorize San Francisco residents who are legal voting age and who are the parents, legal guardians, or caregivers for children in the San Francisco Unified School District to vote in elections for the Board of Education, regardless of whether the resident is a United States citizen.
- Authorize the Board of Supervisors to adopt ordinances implementing non-citizen voting in Board of Education elections.

Non-citizens would be permitted to vote only if they are legal voting age. Currently, voters must be at least 18 years old to vote, but a pending Charter amendment (Board File No. 150267) could lower the voting age to 16 for Board of Education elections and other municipal elections. Like citizens, non-citizens would be disqualified from voting if they are in prison or on parole for conviction of a felony, as required by Article II Section 4 of the California Constitution and implementing State statutes.

The provision authorizing non-citizen voting in Board of Education elections would "sunset" on December 31, 2022, or the December 31 immediately following the third School Board election conducted under the rules adopted in this Charter amendment, whichever is later. The Board of Supervisors, by ordinance, could authorize non-citizen voting in Board of Education elections to continue after that date.

WHEREAS, Rule 2.22.2 provides that any proposed Charter amendment that has not been prepared or approved as to form by the City Attorney "shall be transmitted by the Clerk of the Board to the City Attorney for preparation or approval as to form," and that the City Attorney shall approve the measure as to form or provide a "negative report" within 10 days; and

WHEREAS, Rule 2.22.8 provides, "Notwithstanding the provisions of other rules, the Board may, by motion adopted by a majority vote of all Supervisors thereof, shorten, extend or otherwise modify the time fixed in these rules for the performance of any act by an officer, board or commission concerning a Charter amendment;" and

WHEREAS, Supervisor Mar introduced a proposed Charter amendment on May 24, 2016 without the City Attorney's approval as to form, and intends to introduce a substitute Charter amendment on June 7, 2016, with the City Attorney's approval as to form; now, therefore, be it
