

- 3. No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the petitioner(s) as defined on the ABC-257, dated 04-14-2016.
- 4. Sales, service, or consumption of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. daily.
- 5. Petitioner(s) shall regularly police the area under their control in an effort to prevent the loitering of persons on or about the premises.


