

ALU Recommendation: Approval with the following conditions:

- 1. Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m.
- Loitering (loitering is defined as "to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business") is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under control of the licensee(s) as depicted on the ABC – 257 dated 02/12/16.
- 3. The sale of distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 200 ml is strictly prohibited.
- 4. Not more than 15% of the square footage of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages.
- 5. The sale of beer or malt beverages(s) with an alcoholic content than 5.7 % by volume is prohibited.
- 6. The sale of beer or malt beverages in quantities of 16 oz., 22 oz., 32 oz., 40 oz., or similar size containers is prohibited.
- 7. No beer or malt beverages shall be sold in quantities of less than manufacturer prepackaged six packs per sale with the exception of wine-coolers and beer coolers which must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four (4) or more.
- 8. Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml.
- 9. No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s) as defined on the ABC-257 dated 02/12/16.


