[Opposing the Budget Change Proposal of the California Department of Fish and Wildlife on Commercial Fishing Landing Taxes]

Resolution urging the California State Senate and Assembly to oppose the Budget Change Proposal of the California Department of Fish and Wildlife that would increase commercial fishing landing taxes in the California State Budget FY2017-2018.

WHEREAS, California fisheries are among the most stringently managed in the world and are often considered to be the gold standard of fisheries management; and

WHEREAS, California fisheries help offset the U.S. trade deficit, maintain harbor and port infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, California's fishing communities have suffered through reduced opportunity, the effects of drought, warmer ocean water temperatures, and algal bloom disruptions; and

WHEREAS, The West Coast fisheries have been rebuilt and the communities that depend on them, most importantly the consumers served by the industry, chefs, restaurants and grocers need a supportive economic atmosphere upon which to grow and return to a vibrant economic condition; and

WHEREAS, Many people in the industry trace their heritage to Italy when families emigrated to San Francisco during the Gold Rush in the mid 1800's and are still active in the industry; and

WHEREAS, The San Francisco fishermen and processors are a treasured part of the City's heritage and are part of the flavor and aromas that have made Fisherman's Wharf an international destination; and

WHEREAS, The tax increases will not only destroy the economic margins of the fishermen and processors, but also will have a profound effect on local coastal economies; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the California State Senate and Assembly to oppose this landing tax increase, particularly given the importance of the seafood industry to the State, and the multi-year economic hardship the industry has suffered; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That this Resolution be communicated to our legislative delegation and City lobbyist.
