





VETERANS BUILDING PERFORMANCE VENUES




2019 - 2021 HIGHLIGHTS

Programs and Operations:

- Veterans service organization Swords to Plowshares implemented tenant improvements in the Veterans Building and commenced full-time occupancy in the Veterans Building in May 2019
- New food and beverage concessionaire began service in all three buildings, making investments in equipment and public areas
- Davies Symphony Hall public spaces will receive upgrades in furniture and amenities
- Collaboration with Veterans organizations on exhibit marking centennial of the end of World War I

Capital Projects:

- Design phase for replacement of Opera House mansard/sloped roof
- Opera House and Davies Symphony Hall elevator modernizations
- Opera House rehearsal room floor ADA improvements
- Replacement of original Orchestra Level seating in Opera House (privately funded)




Opera House Roof: Solar PV System to be installed on flat roof; Mansard/sloped roof to be replaced.
