15	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:		
16			
17	Section 1. Findings.		
18	(a) The Planning Department has determined that the actions contemplated in this		
19	ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act (California Public Resources		
20	Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with the Clerk of the Board of		
21	Supervisors in File No. 190731 and is incorporated herein by reference. The Board affirms		
22	this determination.		
23	(b) On, the Planning Commission, in Resolution No,		
24	adopted findings that the actions contemplated in this ordinance are consistent, on balance,		
25	with the City's General Plan and eight priority policies of Planning Code Section 101.1. The		

1	Board adopts these findings as its own. A copy of said Resolution is on file with the Clerk of
2	the Board of Supervisors in File No, and is incorporated herein by reference.
3	(c) Pursuant to Planning Code Section 302, the Board of Supervisors finds that the
4	actions contemplated in this ordinance will serve the public necessity, convenience, and
5	welfare for the reasons set forth in the Planning Commission Resolution referenced above.
6	
7	Section 2. Article 1.7 of the Planning Code is hereby amended by revising Section
8	178, to read as follows:
9	SEC. 178. CONDITIONAL USES.
10	* * * *
11	(d) Abandonment. A permitted conditional use that is discontinued for a period of
12	three years, or otherwise abandoned, shall not be restored, except upon approval of a new
13	conditional use application pursuant to the provisions of Article 3 of this Code. For purposes of
14	this \underline{s} ubsection $\underline{(d)}$, the period of nonuse for a permitted conditional use to be deemed
15	discontinued in the North Beach and Castro Street Neighborhood Commercial Districts, and the
16	Jackson Square Special Use District shall be eighteen (18) months.
17	A permitted conditional Formula Retail use which is discontinued for a period of 18
18	months, or otherwise abandoned, shall not be restored, except upon approval of a new
19	conditional use application pursuant to Article 3 of this Code.
20	* * * *
21	
22	Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
23	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
24	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
25	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

1	Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors		
2	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,		
3	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal		
4	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment		
5	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under		
6	the official title of the ordinance.
