[Authorizing Expenditures - Gift to Compton's District Transgender, Lesbian, Gay, and Bisexual Stabilization Fund - \$300,000]

Resolution authorizing the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development to expend a gift to Compton's District Transgender, Lesbian, Gay, and Bisexual (TLGB) Stabilization Fund dollars in the amount of \$300,000 to support the City's efforts to recognize and support historic and present-day TLGB communities in the Tenderloin neighborhood, for a term of August 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020.

WHEREAS, On March 17, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Ordinance No. 49-17 (the "Ordinance"), which, among other things, accepted a \$300,000 gift from Mid-Market Center LLC (the "Project Sponsor") to the City and County of San Francisco (the "City"), to create the Compton's District Transgender, Lesbian, Gay and Bisexual (TLGB) Stabilization Fund (the "Fund"); and

WHEREAS, The City, acting through the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development (MOHCD), created the Fund to help recognize and support historic and presentday TLGB communities in the Tenderloin neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, The gift was to be paid prior to issuance of the first construction document for the project located at 950-974 Market Street, Assessor's Parcel Block No. 0342, Lots No. 001, 002, 004, and 014 (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, The intent of the Board of Supervisors in accepting the gift was that one third of the gift be used to support the creation of a Compton's TLGB Cultural Heritage District in the Tenderloin and South of Market neighborhoods; one third be used to support the creation of a transgender-focused community facility in the Tenderloin neighborhood; and another third be used to support one or more transgender-focused commercial or nonprofit storefront establishments in the Tenderloin neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, MOHCD shall work with the Supervisor for District 6, members of the community knowledgeable about transgender issues in the Tenderloin, and the Human Rights Commission to help set funding priorities; and

WHEREAS, Expenditures for staffing, loans, grants and property acquisitions and maintenance shall be approved by resolution of the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, MOHCD staff issued a request for proposals (RFP) that was released on June 10, 2019, consistent with the Ordinance, for the Compton's Transgender Cultural District to seek assistance from the Fund; and

WHEREAS, A copy of the Compton's District TLGB Stabilization Funding Recommendations resulting from the RFP has been filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors under File No. 190763; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development is hereby authorized to expend the \$300,000 gift to the Compton's District TLGB Stabilization Fund all in accordance with the purposes and goals for the funding as generally set forth in the Ordinance and the Funding Recommendations filed with the Clerk of the Board.
