Dear Secretary Pompeo,

This letter is in reference to Executive Order 13888, "On Enhancing State and Local Involvement in Resettlement."

I write to affirm that San Francisco consents to the resettlement of refugees within San Francisco under the Department of State's Reception and Placement Program. To alleviate the need for any subsequent consent to be given, this consent is given until revoked.

San Francisco nonetheless contends that Executive Order 13888 violates federal law, and by providing consent San Francisco does not concede that the Executive Order places a lawful condition on the placement of refugees. Refugee resettlement organizations have sued to block the Executive Order. The Executive Order not only violates the law, it undermines the goal of ensuring refugees have the best chance at succeeding in this country by limiting the places available for them to be resettled. The Executive Order stands against the values of acceptance and inclusivity upon which our country was founded.
