10 when a heavy-set man wearing a ski mask approached him and demanded the
11 contents of his cash register; and,

13 WHEREAS, Arinze Anoruo was shot in the head during the commission of
14 that crime and died in surgery that evening; and,

16 WHEREAS, The citizens of San Francisco need to be assured that they
17 will be secure in their person and property and that brazen acts of violence will
18 not go unnoticed and unpunished; now, therefore be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San
21 Francisco urges the Mayor to establish a reward leading to the arrest and
22 conviction of the assailant of Arinze Anoruo.


