10	to the community in countless ways for more than seventy years through many venues, including the
11	Jewish Community Federation which enriches the lives of countless San Franciscans; and
12	WHEREAS, Over the years in addition to raising a family, helping to run the business, Doris
13	has made donations to the Jewish Campership Fund; Dream House, an Israeli children's hospital;
14	Ronald McDonald House; and many other charitable organizations; and,
15	WHEREAS, She has served as a member of Theta Delta Xi, which among other things
16	benefits Jewish Family and Children's Services' (JFCS) Dream House which provides residential and
