

1 [Provide assertive case management to people with HIV and substance abuse and mental  
2 disorders.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, AIDS Office**  
4 **(SFPDH, AIDS) to accept retroactively and expend a grant in the amount of \$490,947**  
5 **from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) for**  
6 **assertive case management for triply-diagnosed people and to enter into an agreement**  
7 **for the use of these funds; for the period of June 1, 2003, to May 30, 2004.**

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9 WHEREAS, SFPDH, AIDS has applied for and been awarded a grant from SAMHSA in  
10 the amount of \$490,947 for assertive case management for triply-diagnosed people; and,

11 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, SAMHSA requires the City to  
12 enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the  
13 Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a part of  
14 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

15 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$2,208; and,

16 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors  
17 because we did not receive the grant award notice until June 6, 2003; and,

18 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds  
19 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually  
20 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure  
21 of grant funding; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That SFPDH, AIDS is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and  
23 expend a grant in the amount of \$490,947 from SAMHSA; and, be it

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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH, AIDS is hereby authorized to accept and  
2 expend the grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement  
3 pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
5 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded  
7 under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the  
8 agreement expires.
