

1 [Accept-Expend Bay Area Air Quality Management District Grant]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Executive Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic**
4 **or his designee to accept and expend \$97,600 from the Transportation Fund for Clean**
5 **Air in the Bay Area to install bicycle racks in various locations and waiving indirect**
6 **costs.**

8 WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 434 created the Transportation Fund for Clean Air in the
9 Bay Area, and provided authority to the Bay Area Air Quality Management District ("the
10 District") to impose up to a \$4.00 surcharge on motor vehicle registration fees within its
11 jurisdiction, to be used to implement specified transportation control measures; and,

12 WHEREAS, On October 16, 1991, the District approved a \$2.00 surcharge on motor
13 vehicle registration fees, and raised the surcharge to \$4.00 effective April 1, 1993; and,

14 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco supports the Bay Area Clean Air
15 Plan; and,

16 WHEREAS, The Department of Parking and Traffic has developed a project for the
17 fiscal year 2000-01 AB434 program funding to install bicycle racks; and,

18 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 634-00 on July 10,
19 2000, authorizing the Director of the Department of Parking and Traffic to apply for up to
20 \$100,000 from the Bay Area Air Quality Management District's Transportation Fund for Clean
21 Air for survey, purchase, and installation of bicycle racks at various public locations; and,

22 WHEREAS, The Parking and Traffic Commission has approved Resolution No. 163-
23 00-PTC at its October 17, 2000 meeting authorizing the Executive Director of the Department
24 of Parking and Traffic or his designee to accept and expend \$97,600 from the Transportation
25 Fund for Clean Air in the Bay Area to install bicycle racks in various locations; and,


1 WHEREAS, Calculating and claiming indirect costs using the methodology required by

13 the grant terminates.
