AUTHORIZING THE SAN FRANCISCO PUBLIC LIBRARY TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND \$72,000 TO BE AWARDED BY THE CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY TO SUPPORT PROJECT READ, THE ADULT LITERACY PROGRAM OF THE SAN FRANCISCO

PUBLIC LIBRARY, AND THAT INDIRECT COSTS BE WAIVED. urging the designation of the positions as grant funded positions.

WHEREAS, San Francisco Public Library has a mission to promote literacy and the joys of reading, and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Public Library's Project Read is the lead community program tutoring English speaking adult non-readers to become readers, and

WHEREAS, literacy empowers people to more fully engage in the democratic process, and

WHEREAS, San Francisco Public Library's Project Read, will receive an adult literacy grant from the California State to support Project Read, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Public Library, be authorized to accept and expend a grant of \$72,000 from the California State Library, to support tutoring activities and operations of Project Read which promotes literacy among non-reading English speaking adults in our community, and that indirect costs be waived.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board urge the Controller to designate the positions created under the proposed grant as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when grant expires.




