5 WHEREAS, Charles "Les" Andersen was born in San Francisco on May  
6 31, 1934; and,

7 WHEREAS, Les first became involved with the San Francisco Boys &  
8 Girls Club at the age of eight when he became a member of the Mission  
9 branch; and,

10 WHEREAS, Les held a number of positions at San Francisco Boys &  
11 Girls Clubs including Library Director, Aquatics Director, Athletic  
12 Director and Branch Director; and,

13 WHEREAS, Les completed his degree at New York University on a  
14 scholarship from the Boys Club of America; and,

15 WHEREAS, Les was named Assistant Executive Director of the San  
16 Francisco Boys & Girls Club in 1959 and later became Executive  
17 Director in 1969; and,

18 WHEREAS, As Executive Director, Les was responsible for ensuring  
19 that the San Francisco Boys Club became the first club on the West  
20 Coast to allow girls to become members; and,

21 WHEREAS, Les has contributed much to the enrichment of inner  
22 city youth including opening club branches in the Sunnydale and Alice  
23 Griffith public housing areas, overseeing the expansion of Camp  
24 Mendocino which now serves 1,600 inner city kids each summer, and  
25 building the San Francisco Boys & Girls Club Endowment; and,




