3	Resolution commemorating the 60 th anniversary of the repeal of the Chinese Exclusion
4	Act.

6	WHEREAS, The Chinese Exclusion Act of 1882 singled out race, namely Chinese
7	ancestry and other Asian ancestries, as the main requirement for controlling certain persons,
8	including American citizens, within, exiting and entering this country; and,
9	WHEREAS, The Chinese Exclusion Act and its subsequent derivative laws legitimized
0	an unjust national policy from an outgrowth of prejudice, hatred, and scapegoating which
1	originated in California; and,
2	WHEREAS, The restrictions of the Chinese Exclusion Act effectively led to the
3	destruction of communities and the deliberate division of families and the separation of
4	husbands and wives; and,
5	WHEREAS, Sixty years after the repeal, the legacy of the Exclusion Act persists
6	among survivors who retain bitter memories and among their descendants troubled by
7	unresolved questions of family history and self-identity; and,
8	WHEREAS, For the advancement of our great Nation, acts correcting grave injustices
9	such as the Chinese Exclusion Act must be remembered and commemorated to foster
20	healing, greater understanding and appreciation of all our peoples; now, therefore, be it
21	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commemorates the 60 th anniversary of the
22	repeal of the Chinese Exclusion Act on December 17, 2003; and be it
23	FURTHER RESOLVED, That all citizens of the diverse State of California pledge
24	themselves to achieve greater harmony by increasing mutual understanding and respect

2	Chinese Exclusion Act.
