[Urging improved cleanup and oversight of Boeddeker Park]

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS AND THE SAN FRANCISCO POLICE

DEPARTMENT TO IMPROVE THEIR EFFORTS TO MAINTAIN A CLEAN AND SAFE AREA

AROUND BOEDDEKER PARK, SPECIFICALLY BY TRIMMING THE TREES AND STEAM

CLEANING THE SIDEWALKS OUTSIDE THE GATES, AND BY MAINTAINING REGULAR

POLICE PATROLS IN THE AREA.

WHEREAS, The Tenderloin neighborhood is a residential area that is home to increasing numbers of children and seniors; and,

WHEREAS, Boeddeker Park is one of few open spaces in the neighborhood and can provide outdoor recreation opportunities for residents, particularly children and seniors; and,

WHEREAS, The Rotary Club has recently contributed toward extensive renovation of Boeddeker Park, replacing the children's play area; and,

WHEREAS, Access to the park, including the new play area, is severely limited by health and safety hazards at the back entrance of the park, including drug sales and use, alcohol consumption, muggings, used syringes, broken bottles, feces and urine; and,

WHEREAS, Boeddeker Park Recreation staff have been threatened and assaulted as they have attempted to clear this area; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Public Works and the San Francisco Police Department to improve their efforts to maintain a clean and safe area around Boeddeker Park,

specifically by trimming the trees and steam cleaning the sidewalks outside the gates, and by maintaining regular police patrols in the area; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the Board forward this resolution to the Department of Public Works and the San Francisco Police Department's Tenderloin Task Force.
