13	In addition to public offenses created by the Vehicle Code, the actions listed in this		
14	Section 7.2 are prohibited, and each and every violation of a prohibition listed below shall be		
15	an infraction, except as otherwise provided in: (a) this Code; or (b) the Vehicle Code; or (c) as		
16	necessary to comply with the direction of a Police Officer or Parking Control Officer; or (d) with		
17	respect to a Municipal Parking Facility, upon the direction of an authorized parking attendant;		
18	or (e) with respect to any other Public Property, except with the permission of, and subject to		
19	such conditions and regulations as are imposed by the agency that owns the property that are		
20	available for public inspection at the agency's offices.		
21	SEC. 7.2.104. CLIPPER CARD REGULATIONS.		
22	(a) To fail to display a valid Clipper card at the request of any authorized representative of the		
23	transit system or duly authorized peace officer while on a transit vehicle or in a Proof of Payment		
24	Zone.		
25	(b) To misuse any Clipper card with the intent to evade the payment of any fare.		

1	(c) To knowingly use or attempt to use any illegally printed, duplicated, or otherwise			
2	reproduced Clipper card for entry onto any transit vehicle or into any transit station with the intent of			
3	evading payment of a fare.			
4		(d) For any unauthorized person to use a discount Clipper card or fail to present, upon reques		
5	<u>from</u>	from a system fare inspector, acceptable proof of eligibility to use a discount Clipper card.
