I'm a resident and homeowner in Bayview for over 11 years now. I am applying for community seat 6 on the Urban Forestry Council. I believe I am the best candidate because I am an extremely active community organizer who is dedicated to greening our neighborhood and city.

I have the support of my community and the urban forestry community, because I have worked so hard to support my neighbors and to make our neighborhood someplace we can be proud of.

To be a positive force for change, I contacted the Friends of the Urban Forest and became the Bayview-Hunters Point volunteer neighborhood organizer for tree planting. Since then I've organized over a half-dozen tree plantings, which resulted in over 350 new trees in District 10. Recently I've been organizing a planting for January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2010. To do even more for the neighborhood, and to meet other community leaders, I created the BetterBayview online community forum three years ago, which I continue to maintain and use for outreach.

It's my nature to engage as many people as possible, and I use every opportunity to reach out to as many people as I can to increase the health and size of the San Francisco urban forest. Beyond planting and tree aftercare, I attend many events in Bayview-Hunters Point and I use these events to promote tree planting and to educate people on the benefit of urban trees.

Trees are an important environmental justice issue in Bayview. The council's own street tree analysis shows that District 10 has one of the lowest percentages of tree canopy coverage in the city. I am a strong voice for changing that and want to be able to represent my community, and other communities, including those with economic obstacles to tree planting.

The tree planting days have united my neighbors and me, which became especially important when we needed to work together to protect our new plantings from vandalism. We've all enjoyed the tangible and intangible benefits the street trees provide.

I used to say, "I wish I lived in a better neighborhood." Because I realized it was my responsibility to make it happen, now I do.

As a Bayview District resident and a long-time volunteer with Friends of the Urban Forest, I am writing in enthusiastic recommendation of Matt Czajkowski for the open seat of the Urban Forestry Council.

I have known Matt for several years, and have nothing but admiration for him personally and politically. He is extremely active as a member of this traditionally under-represented corner of the city, and has used his remarkable gift for making social connections in furtherance of the development of a rapidly-burgeoning Bayview-positive community. He is the creator of BetterBayview, an online group dedicated to bringing diverse people together to improve our neighborhood and support one another (which he moderates), and has served as a moving force for the establishment of semi-regular neighborhood gatherings which draw attention to new businesses and foster the growth of the social network.

He is an extremely visible and passionate volunteer with FUF, organizing numerous plantings, and, from the Bayview plantings, posting numerous photos online to help foster increased awareness and activism in this cause.

Matt's qualifications for this position include his passionate advocacy for the Bayview district, his ability to form positive connections with people from all backgrounds, his knowledge of and sensitivity to neighborhood-specific issues, his technological savvy, his extraordinarily articulate demeanor, and his genuine concern for the ecology of San Francisco. Ordinance 21-01 (Admin. Code Chapter 5 Article XXIII). Ordinance 171-03 (repealed Admin. Code Chapter 5, Article XXIII). Ordinance No. 210-08 restructured the Council.

**Board Qualifications:**

The Urban Forestry Council composition and administration was restructured by Ordinance No. 210-08 as follows:

Council members will represent the full range of urban forest stakeholders including city agencies, non-profit organizations, tree management organizations, and community members.

The Urban Forestry Council shall be comprised of 11 total members, 7 of whom will be appointed by the Board of Supervisors as follows:

One representative from an educational organization involved with tree management (University of California Cooperative Extension, etc.);

Two members certified by a professional tree management organization (International Society of Arboriculture, American Society of Consulting Arborists, or American Society of Landscape Architects);

Two members of non-profit organizations involved in urban forestry or other environmentally-related issues; and

Two members from the community.

The Mayor shall appoint two voting members as follows:

One member from the tree care industry; and one member at large.

The following departments shall have voting members:

Director of the Department of Public Works or designee; Director of the Planning Department or designee.

The Council shall have advisory members comprised of representatives from the following departments: Recreation and Park Department and Public Utilities Commission.

In addition, the San Francisco Redevelopment Agency, and the Golden Gate National Recreation Area are invited to send representatives to sit as advisory members of the Council. The Body that appoints Council members also may appoint at-large members to serve any unfilled Council positions. Members shall serve for a term of two-years. Members can serve successive terms if reappointed by the body originally appointing the Council member. The Council shall meet at least once each month and establish its own operating procedures, which at a minimum, shall meet the public notice, meeting, voting, agenda and other procedural requirements set forth in local law. Subcommittees shall be created to adequately address other special areas of concern on an as needed basis. The Department of the Environment, with adequate funding to assist the Council in carrying out its mission, shall provide professional and administrative staff to the Council.

As newly constituted by Ordinance No. 210-08, at 12:00 noon on the 30th day following the effective date of this ordinance (Nov. 18, 2008), the tenures of the persons currently holding seats on the Urban Forestry Council shall expire. The eleven persons appointed as members of the Urban Forestry Council as provided in this Section shall assume office at 12:00 noon on November 18, 2008; provided that if any appointing authority has not made a new appointment by such date, the sitting member shall continue to serve for sixty days. The two-year terms of those members appointed pursuant to subsections (a)(1), (a)(2), and (a)(3) shall commence on that date.
