

1 [Accept-Expend Federal Grant – Special Emphasis Victim Assistance Program: Elder Abuse]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the District Attorney of the City and County**
4 **of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$155, 000**
5 **through the California Office of Criminal Justice Planning for the operation of a**
6 **program entitled “Elder Abuse Vertical Prosecution Program.”**

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8 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to continue a certain project
9 designated the Elder Abuse Vertical Prosecution Program to be funded in part from funds
10 made available through the Office of Criminal Justice Planning (OCJP); and,

11 WHEREAS, All positions supported by these funds shall be coded “G” in the District
12 Attorney’s budget; and,

13 WHEREAS, The terms of the grant prohibit inclusion of indirect costs in the grant
14 budget; now, therefore, be it

15 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of the City
16 and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend funds from OCJP for the
17 purposes of the elder abuse vertical prosecution program; and, be it

18 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
19 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of
21 the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for purposes of
22 elder abuse vertical prosecution program, including any extensions, augmentations or
23 amendments thereof; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized and empowered to
25 execute, deliver and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all

1 applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary for the
2 purpose of securing elder abuse vertical prosecution program grant funds and to implement
3 and carry out the purposes specified in the applicable grant application; and be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant
5 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the
6 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to
8 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
