16	of the determinations with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, which the Clerk of the Board
17	of Supervisors received on or around December 31, 2004 and January 7, 2005, respectively;

19	WHEREAS, On February 15, 2005, this Board held a duly noticed public hearing to
20	consider the appeals of the determinations; and,
21	WHEREAS, This Board has reviewed and considered the determinations, the appeal
22	letters, the responses to concerns document that the Planning Department prepared, and
23	public testimony; and,
24	WHEREAS, The determination files and all correspondence and other documents have
