8	WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Article 6, provides for the temporary use and
9	occupancy of a public street for events receiving a permit from the Interdepartmental Staff
10	Committee on Traffic and Transportation (ISCOTT); and
11	WHEREAS, Transportation Code, Section 6.7, provides that the temporary use or
12	occupancy of a public street shall not unnecessarily obstruct or bar public access onto said
13	street, and that sidewalks shall remain open at all times for pedestrian use unless closure of
14	the sidewalk is provided for by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors explaining the reason
15	for such closure; and
16	WHEREAS, Workday Rising is an annual event that has signed agreements to be held
17	at the Moscone Center in 2025; and
18	WHEREAS, Workday Rising will bring over 15,000 visitors to the City this year when it
19	takes place at the Moscone Center and surrounding streets over four days; and
20	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors determines that the closure of the sidewalks on
21	both sides of Howard Street between 3rd Street and 4th Street, from September 14 through
22	September 19, 2025, is necessary to facilitate the event; and
23	WHEREAS, Authorization for the temporary closure of the above sidewalks is subject
24	to ISCOTT issuing a permit for the event; and

WHEREAS, This Resolution is not a stand-alone authorization to close the subject
sidewalks; any such closures are subject to ISCOTT approving an event permit for each
year's Workday Rising event that authorizes closure of the subject sidewalks and is subject to
