Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to authorize the Airport Commission to accept certain gifts, devises, and bequests of objects or other articles for the SFO Museum collection.

Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

Section 1. Findings.

- (a) The Airport Commission created and operates the SFO Museum, which manages a permanent collection for use in public programs in the San Francisco Airport Commission Aviation Library and Louis A. Turpen Aviation Museum and conducts ongoing collection development through acquisitions by purchase and gifts of objects appropriate to the collection.
- (b) The Airport Commission periodically receives offers of gifts for the SFO Museum valued at greater than \$10,000, and Administrative Code Section 10.100-305 provides that the acceptance or expenditure of any gift of cash or goods of a market value greater than \$10,000 requires approval of the Board of Supervisors, by resolution.
- (c) Under Charter Section 5.100, the governing boards of the Arts Commission, the Asian Art Museum of San Francisco, the Fine Arts Museums of San Francisco, and the War Memorial and Performing Arts Center may accept loans, gifts, devises, bequests, or

agreements donating works of art or other assets to their respective departments without action of the Board of Supervisors, so long as acceptance of the same entails no expense for the City beyond ordinary care and maintenance.

(d) By Resolution No. 18-0197, adopted on June 19, 2018 (the "Commission Resolution"), the Airport Commission requested that the Administrative Code be amended to likewise authorize the Airport Commission to accept gifts, devises, and bequests of objects or other articles for the SFO Museum collection when the acceptance of the same entails no expense on the part of the Commission beyond the ordinary care and maintenance of such objects or other articles. A copy of the Commission Resolution is on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 180925

Section 2. Chapter 10, Article XIII, of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Section 10.100-305, to read as follows:

SEC. 10.100-305. SAN FRANCISCO GIFT FUNDS.

(a) Establishment and Use of Funds. The Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the creation of category eight funds or accounts for the purpose of accepting any gift of cash or goods which may from time to time be offered to the City and County of San Francisco through any department, board, or commission thereof, for the benefit of the designated department, board, or commission and for such purposes within its prescribed legal jurisdiction as may be specified by the donors. The Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize said departments, boards, and commissions to receive and to administer such gifts in accordance with the wishes of the donors. All such gifts will be promptly reported to the Controller.

- (b) **Exceptions to Fund Category.** The acceptance or expenditure of any gift of cash or goods of a market value greater than \$10,000 shall require approval of the Board of Supervisors, by resolution.
- (c) Administrative Provisions. Each department, board, and commission accepting gifts authorized hereunder shall furnish to the Board of Supervisors annually within the first two weeks of July a report showing such gifts received, the nature or amount of said gifts, and the disposition thereof.
- (d) Airport Commission. Notwithstanding subsection (b), the Airport Commission may accept gifts, devises, and bequests of objects or other articles for the SFO Museum collection without action of the Board of Supervisors when such acceptance entails no expense on the part of the Airport Commission beyond the ordinary care and maintenance of such objects or other articles for exhibition purposes. All gifts, devises, and bequests of objects or other articles for the SFO Museum collection made prior to the effective date of the ordinance in Board of Supervisors File No. 180925, that entail no expense beyond the ordinary care and maintenance thereof for exhibition purposes, are hereby accepted for the purposes for which they were given. This subsection (d) does not limit or abridge the Arts Commission's authority with respect to works of art as set forth in Charter Section 5.103 and Administrative Code Section 2A.150.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,

numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under the official title of the ordinance.

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Acceptance of Gifts - SFO Museum]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to authorize the Airport Commission to accept certain gifts, devises, and bequests of objects or other articles for the SFO Museum collection.

Existing Law

Administrative Code Section 10.100-305 allows designated departments, boards, or commissions, including the Airport Commission, to accept, receive, and administer gifts bequeathed for the benefit of said departments, boards, or commissions. However, the Board of Supervisors must approve any gift with a market value greater than \$10,000.

Amendments to Current Law

By adding clause (d) to Administrative Code Section 10.100-305, the proposed ordinance would allow the Airport Commission to accept gifts with a market value greater than \$10,000 for the SFO Museum collection without action from the Board of Supervisors when such acceptance entails no expense on the part of the Airport Commission beyond the ordinary care and maintenance of such gifts.

Background Information

The Airport Commission established the SFO Museum on October 15, 1991. The SFO Museum manages a permanent collection and conducts ongoing collection development through acquisitions by purchase and gifts of objects appropriate to the collection focus. Periodically, gifts valued at greater than \$10,000 are offered for donation to the SFO Museum collection. All gifts are reviewed for compliance with the SFO Museum Collection Management Policy and are presented for approval by the SFO Museum Collection Review Committee. SFO Museum has stated that the proposed ordinance would support its efforts to execute appropriate deeds of gift in a prompt manner that preserves productive donor relations.

Under Charter Section 5.100, the governing boards of the Arts Commission, the Asian Art Museum of San Francisco, the Fine Arts Museums of San Francisco, and the War Memorial and Performing Arts Center may accept loans, gifts, devises, bequests, or agreements donating works of art or other assets to their respective departments without action of the Board of Supervisors, so long as acceptance of the same entails no expense for the City beyond ordinary care and maintenance. Therefore, the proposed ordinance would align SFO Museum with these other City-owned museums that are authorized to accept gifts valued at greater than \$10,000 without Board approval.

WHEREAS,	Section 10.100-305 of the San Francisco Administrative Code provides that the acceptance or expenditure of any gift of cash or goods of a market value greater than \$10,000 shall require approval of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors (the "Board"), by resolution; and
WHEREAS,	on October 15, 1991, the Commission adopted Resolution No. 91-0182 to create an aviation library and museum in the new International Terminal, now named the San Francisco Airport Commission Aviation Library and Louis A. Turpen Aviation Museum, as part of SFO Museum; and
WHEREAS,	SFO Museum manages a permanent collection for use in public programs in the San Francisco Airport Commission Aviation Library and Louis A. Turpen Aviation Museum and conducts ongoing collection development through acquisitions by purchase and gifts of objects appropriate to the collection focus; and
WHEREAS,	gifts valued at greater than \$10,000 are periodically offered for donation to the SFO Museum collection; and
WHEREAS,	to ensure the accession of appropriate and desirable objects to the SFO Museum collection, each gift is reviewed for compliance with the SFO Museum Collection Management Policy and is presented for approval by the SFO Museum Collection Review Committee; and
WHEREAS,	other City-owned museums are authorized to accept gifts valued at greater than \$10,000 without Board approval; and
WHEREAS,	in order to allow SFO Museum to execute appropriate deeds of gift in a prompt manner that preserves productive donor relations, it is necessary and desirable to

request an amendment to the San Francisco Administrative Code to authorize the

- RESOLVED, that this Commission requests that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors amend the San Francisco Administrative Code to authorize the Commission to accept gifts, devises and bequests of objects or other articles for the SFO Museum collection when the acceptance of the same entails no expense on the part of the Commission beyond the ordinary care and maintenance of such objects or other articles.

DIRECTOR'S RECOMMENDATION: ADOPT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE SAN FRANCISCO BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AMEND THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSION TO ACCEPT CERTAIN GIFTS OF OBJECTS TO SFO MUSEUM.

Executive Summary

Currently, San Francisco Administrative Code Section 10.100-305 provides that the acceptance or expenditure of any gift of cash or goods of a market value greater than \$10,000 shall require approval of the San Francisco Board of Supervisors (the "Board"), by resolution. The proposed resolution would authorize the Director to request the Board to amend the Administrative Code to allow the Commission to accept certain gifts, devises and bequests of objects or other articles to SFO Museum.

Background

SFO Museum manages a permanent collection for use in public programs in the San Francisco Commission Aviation Library and Louis A. Turpen Aviation Museum and conducts ongoing collection development through acquisitions by purchase and gifts of objects appropriate to its collection focus. Gifts of objects and other articles, including those valued at greater than \$10,000, are periodically offered for donation to SFO Museum. To ensure the accession of appropriate and desirable objects to the SFO Museum collection, each gift is reviewed for compliance with the SFO Museum Collection Management Policy and is presented for approval by the SFO Museum Collection Review Committee.

Under Administrative Code Section 10.100-305, Board approval is required before the Commission can accept or expend any gift of cash or goods of a market value

IVAR C. SATERO AIRPORT DIRECTOR greater than \$10,000. This includes gifts to SFO Museum. Other City-owned museums are authorized under the Administrative Code to accept gifts valued greater than \$10,000 without Board approval. A similar delegation of authority to the Commission would be beneficial because it would allow the Commission to accept gifts in a prompt manner that preserves productive donor relations for SFO Museum.

Airport staff therefore recommends that the Commission authorize the Director to request the Board to amend the Administrative Code to allow the Commission to accept gifts, devises and bequests of objects or other articles for the SFO Museum collection when the acceptance of the same entails no expense on the part of the Commission beyond the ordinary care and maintenance of such objects or other articles. This change would most likely be made in Administrative Code Section 10.100-305 or Section 2A.155.

The Commission would continue to report acceptance of gifts pursuant to Administrative Code Sections 10.100-305 and 67.29-6.

Recommendation

I recommend that the Commission approve a request to the San Francisco Board of Supervisors to amend the Administrative Code to allow the Commission to accept certain gifts, devises and bequests of objects or other articles to SFO Museum.
