

1 [Authorizing the Sheriff's Department to amend its contract with ARAMARK Correctional
2 Services, LLC, for Jail Food Services]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Sheriff's Department to enter into a second**
4 **amendment to the agreement between the City and County and ARAMARK**
5 **Correctional Services, LLC, to increase the contract amount from \$15.2 million**
6 **to an amount not to exceed \$27.0 million and to extend the contract term to**
7 **June 30, 2010.**

9 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors approved a contract for the preparation
10 and provision of meals in the San Francisco County Jails with ARAMARK Correctional
11 Services, LLC, (formerly ARAMARK Correctional Services, Inc) contained in File No.
12 050216, dated February 15, 2005, in the amount of \$15,227,132 with a four-year term;
13 and,

14 WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department executed the First Amendment to the
15 Agreement March 16, 2007, to increase contract prices in accordance with the terms of
16 the agreement; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department anticipates that the previously authorized
18 amount of \$15,227,132 is insufficient for the remainder of the contract term; and,

20 WHEREAS, Charter Section 9.118, "Contract and Lease Limitations", subsection
21 (b), requires Board of Supervisors' approval of an amendment of greater than \$500,000
22 to a contract of greater than \$10 million; and,

24 WHEREAS, The Sheriff's Department has prepared proposed Second
25 Amendment to increase the total contract amount to \$27.0 million and to extend the

1 term of the Agreement to June 30, 2010, which amendment is on file with the Clerk of
2 the Board of Supervisors in File No. 081110, which is hereby declared to be a part of
3 this resolution as if set forth fully herein; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Sheriff's Department
5 to execute the second amendment to the Agreement with ARAMARK Correctional
6 Services, LLC in increasing the contract total to an amount not to exceed \$27.0 million
7 and extending the contract term through June 30, 2010.
