

1 [Grant to support the Public Health Laboratory Director Training Program.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH), to**
4 **retroactively accept and expend funds from the California Department of Health**
5 **Services, Division of Communicable Disease Control for the Public Health Laboratory**
6 **Director Training Program, in the amount of \$300,655, for the period of April 1, 2007**
7 **through March 31, 2009.**

9 WHEREAS, DPH applied for and was awarded two grants (Assistant Public Health Lab
10 Director Position and the Public Health Laboratory Equipment and Supplies) for a total of
11 \$300,655 from the California Department of Health Services (CDHS), Division of
12 Communicable Disease Control to support the Public Health Laboratory Director Training
13 Program, for the period of April 1, 2007, through March 31, 2009; and,

14 WHEREAS, These grants allow for the training of a public health laboratory director
15 (\$230,800) and allow for the materials and supplies (\$69,855) involved in such training; and,

16 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDHS requires the City to
17 enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
18 Board of Supervisors in File No. 070626; which is hereby declared to be a part of this
19 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

20 WHEREAS, The grant budget does not include a provision for indirect costs in order to
21 maximize use of grant funds on direct services; and,

22 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an ASO amendment and reimburses the
23 department for an existing Chief Microbiologist position (Job Class 2466) at 1.00 FTE from
24 April 1, 2007 through March 31, 2009; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
2 in the amount of \$300,655 from the CDHS, Division of Communicable Disease Control; and,
3 be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
5 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
6 be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
8 indirect costs in the budget; and be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
10 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded
12 under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the
13 agreement expires.
