13	involving pedestrians with the City and County of San Francisco; and
14	WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors is supportive of measures which will increase
15	driver awareness of pedestrian crosswalks and safety particularly in areas near pre-K
16	kindergarten through grade 12 school sites, senior centers, senior housing complexes,
17	hospitals, major parks, youth recreation centers, public museums and performing arts centers
18	and,
19	WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has begun to install new oversized
20	fluorescent yellow-green pedestrian signage approved by the state Department of
21	Transportation including ladder style markings; now, therefore, be it
22	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the Department of Parking and
23	Traffic to install the state approved oversized fluorescent yellow-green pedestrian signage and
24	yellow ladder stripping in all crosswalks within the City and County of San Francisco that are
25	contiguous to all pre-K kindergarten through grade 12 school zones, senior centers, senior

1	housing complexes, hospitals, major parks, youth recreation centers, public museums, and
2	performing arts centers as soon as possible; and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commends the Department of
4	Parking and Traffic on its efforts and requests that the Department of Parking and Traffic
5	report on its progress ein placing such signage and markings in those areas to the Board on
6	an annual basis beginning with January_2002.
