

1 [Sewer Emergency]

2 **APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY WORK TO**
3 **REPLACE THE STRUCTURALLY INADEQUATE BRICK SEWER ON 4TH STREET**
4 **BETWEEN FOLSOM STREET AND HOWARD STREET.**

5 **WHEREAS**, On January 15, 1998, PUC Sewer Operations identified an emergency condition on
6 4th Street, between Folsom Street and Howard Street; and

7 **WHEREAS**, The existing 3'x5' brick sewer had collapsed, causing a 4'x5' sinkhole to appear in
8 the street, and immediate replacement was required in order to protect the health, welfare, and property
9 of the Citizens of San Francisco; and

10 **WHEREAS**, DPW's Bureau of Engineering prepared the Plans and Specifications for Contract
11 No. CW-151E, "4th Street Emergency Sewer Replacement" to replace the 3'x5' brick sewer; and

12 **WHEREAS**, The Contractor, Shaw Pipelines, Inc., began the emergency work on January 28,
13 1998 and completed it on February 17, 1998; and

14 **WHEREAS**, Because this was an emergency contract, HRC subcontracting goals were not
15 established by the HRC Contract Compliance Officer assigned to monitor the Clean Water sewer
16 replacement program; and

17 **WHEREAS**, The cost of the project is estimated to be \$133,040.00, of which \$99,040.00 is for
18 the construction contract. Funds are available from the Repair and Replacement Fund (Fund
19 5C/CPF/R&R, FAMIS Project No. CENRNR952, Job Order No. 1576N); and

20 **WHEREAS**, The Public Utilities Commission, in accordance with the provisions of Section 6.30
21 of the Administrative Code of the City and County of San Francisco, declared the existence of an
22 emergency; now, therefore, be it

23 **RESOLVED**, That this Board of Supervisors hereby approves the expenditure of funds for the
24 emergency work to replace the structurally inadequate brick sewer on 4th Street between Folsom and
25 Howard Streets.
