Resolution approving the San Joaquin River Group Authority Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement and Division Agreement and authorizing the President and General Manager of the Public Utilities Commission to execute these agreements on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco.

WHEREAS, Merced Irrigation District, Modesto Irrigation District, Oakdale Irrigation District, South San Joaquin Irrigation District, Turlock Irrigation District, San Joaquin River Exchange Contractors Water Authority and its member agencies, and Friant Water Users Authority and its member agencies hold pre-1914 and post-1914 appropriative, riparian and contractual water rights on rivers tributary to the San Joaquin River; and

WHEREAS, in 1996 the aforementioned water agencies formed the San Joaquin River Group Authority by executing a Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement in order to jointly: (1) investigate, plan, monitor, control, regulate and mitigate impacts of water projects on the fish and wildlife resources of the San Joaquin River and the Bay-Delta Estuary, and (2) investigate, plan, fund and construct additional water supply projects such as off-stream and ground water storage, conjunctive use, conservation and water marketing to meet flows for fish and wildlife or for the needs of member agencies, and

WHEREAS, San Francisco also holds senior pre-1914 appropriative water rights on the Tuolumne River, which is tributary to the San Joaquin River; and

WHEREAS, the San Joaquin River Group Authority has asked San Francisco to join the joint powers authority by executing the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement and a corresponding Division Agreement on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File which is hereby declared to be a part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and No.

WHEREAS, San Francisco's participation in the San Joaquin River Group Authority would assist in advancing protection for the fish and wildlife resources of the San Joaquin River and the Bay-Delta Estuary while protecting San Francisco's water supply; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the agreements serve a substantial public interest and it is in the interest of the people of the City and County of San Francisco to enter into the agreements with the San Joaquin River Group Authority; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves the Joint Exercise of Powers Agreement and corresponding Division Agreement for the San Joaquin River Group Authority and authorizes the President and General Manager of the Public Utilities Commission to execute these agreements on behalf of the City.
