4 **the City and County of San Francisco for \$120,000; the lawsuit was filed on**
5 **January 15, 2019, in San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC-19-572800; entitled**
6 **David Timothy Rudolf v. City and County of San Francisco, et al.; the lawsuit involves**
7 **alleged personal injury on a City street.**

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. Pursuant to Charter Section 6.102(5), the Board of Supervisors hereby
11 authorizes the City Attorney to settle the action entitled David Timothy Rudolf v. City and
12 County of San Francisco, et al., San Francisco Superior Court, Case No. CGC19-572800 by
13 the payment of \$120,000. The lawsuit involves alleged personal injury on a City street.

14 Section 2. The above-named action was filed in San Francisco Superior Court on
15 January 15, 2019, and the following parties were named in the lawsuit: plaintiff David Timothy
16 Rudolf; defendant City and County of San Francisco.
