The move to 522 Sutter St. will enable Mr. Zakout to continue to provide his friendly service to the neighborhood, but in a new and improved space.

This move will serve to benefit the community, and will in no way create any additional strain on local law enforcement. For this reason, I urge you to make a determination of public convenience or necessity.
