Neighborhood Outreach

While your files may indicate that 13 protests exist against the application, it is important to note that none of these protests, except for the conditional protest filed by SFPD, were filed against Mr. Zakout's application. Rather, these protests were filed against the application previously submitted for this premises by Dean Zain Azzghayer (21-516866). However, these protests were carried over to Mr. Zakout's application by statute due to the fact that Mr. Zakout submitted his application within one year of the withdrawal of Mr. Azzghayer's application. Mr. Zakout is not in any way related to or affiliated with Mr. Azzghayer.


SFPD withdrew its conditional protest when Mr. Zakout agreed to SFPD's requested conditions, and Mr. Zakout has been working diligently to obtain withdrawals from all of other protestants who filed protests against Mr. Azzghayer's application. To date, Mr. Zakout has obtained protest withdrawals from nine (9) of the protestants. Three of the remaining protestants have not been located, and the other remaining protest was filed by a competitor whose business is located up the street from the Café. To date, he has refused to withdraw his protest.

Conclusion

Mr. Zakout has operated the Café in a responsible and conscientious manner for the past 22 years, and will continue to do so at his new location. The neighborhood does not oppose this application, as evidenced by the fact that there were no protests specifically filed against Mr. Zakout's application (other than the conditional protest by SFPD). Furthermore, the Board's approval of this application would not add to the license concentration levels in the census tract, as Mr. Zakout will be transferring his existing license to a new and improved location located across the street from his existing business - approximately 85 feet away. For these reasons, Mr. Zakout respectfully requests that the Board determine that public convenience or necessity will be served by the issuance of a Type-21 license to the Store. 

Dear Members of the Neighborhood Services and Safety Committee:

We represent Naser Zakout in connection with his application to transfer his existing Type-21 license, currently held at 539 Sutter St., across the street to his new location at 522 Sutter St. We have been informed by the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control ("ABC") that a determination of public convenience or necessity by the Board of Supervisors is a condition to the ABC's issuance of this license. On behalf of Mr. Zakout, we respectfully request that the Board determine that approving the transfer of Mr. Zakout's license to his new store will serve public convenience or necessity.

Project Description

Owned and operated by Mr. Zakout since 1991, Theatre Too Café (the "Café") has been serving hearty Middle Eastern food, fresh sandwiches, and a selection of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages to the residents and visitors in the Union Square neighborhood for the past 22 years. The Café, which is well known for its friendly service, is losing its lease in a few months and desires to move across the street to a new and improved space, where it will continue to operate as Theatre Too Cafe. Mr. Zakout wishes to transfer his existing license to this new location. There will be no increase to the number of licenses in the census tract.

The Sale of Alcohol at the Store will serve Public Convenience or Necessity

One reason the community has supported Mr. Zakout's business for so long is because of his reputation as a good neighbor. The sale of alcoholic beverages at the Café is critical to the success of the business because customers expect that a business like Mr. Zakout's will carry alcohol, and the Café would certainly struggle to survive without this product line, yet Mr. Zakout makes every effort to ensure that these products are only sold in a responsible manner. He is the type of operator that is good for the neighborhood, and by allowing him to continue to sell alcoholic beverages at his new location, the Board will ensure that this privilege is being granted to a small business that cares about the neighborhood and will not create an additional

burden on local law enforcement. In addition, it will provide residents and visitors to the area the convenience of one-stop shopping in a safe and friendly environment.

Neighborhood Outreach

While your files may indicate that 13 protests exist against the application, it is important to note that none of these protests, except for the conditional protest filed by SFPD, were filed against Mr. Zakout's application. Rather, these protests were filed against the application previously submitted for this premises by Dean Zain Azzghayer (21-516866). However, these protests were carried over to Mr. Zakout's application by statute due to the fact that Mr. Zakout submitted his application within one year of the withdrawal of Mr. Azzghayer's application. Mr. Zakout is not in any way related to or affiliated with Mr. Azzghayer.

SFPD withdrew its conditional protest when Mr. Zakout agreed to SFPD's requested conditions, and Mr. Zakout has been working diligently to obtain withdrawals from all of other protestants who filed protests against Mr. Azzghayer's application. To date, Mr. Zakout has obtained protest withdrawals from nine (9) of the protestants. Three of the remaining protestants have not been located, and the other remaining protest was filed by a competitor whose business is located up the street from the Café. To date, he has refused to withdraw his protest.

Conclusion

Mr. Zakout has operated the Café in a responsible and conscientious manner for the past 22 years, and will continue to do so at his new location. The neighborhood does not oppose this application, as evidenced by the fact that there were no protests specifically filed against Mr. Zakout's application (other than the conditional protest by SFPD). Furthermore, the Board's approval of this application would not add to the license concentration levels in the census tract, as Mr. Zakout will be transferring his existing license to a new and improved location located across the street from his existing business – approximately 85 feet away. For these reasons, Mr. Zakout respectfully requests that the Board determine that public convenience or necessity will be served by the issuance of a Type-21 license to the Store.
