2 Master Plan]

4 **Resolution urging the Planning Director to monitor the development of San Francisco**
5 **State University's Master Plan.**

7 WHEREAS, San Francisco State University has embarked on a campus Master Plan
8 that will establish a long-term vision for the physical environment and identify improvements
9 to occur over the next decade; and

10 WHEREAS, Improvements will focus on how to accommodate increased enrollment
11 and academic initiatives; and,

12 WHEREAS, Currently a draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) is being prepared in
13 order to assess the impact on each identified area of interest; and,

14 WHEREAS, The Master Plan attempts to minimize potential impacts on the
15 surrounding neighborhoods by renovating and modernizing academic and residential
16 buildings with an emphasis towards transit-oriented development, including alternative
17 transportation measures such as MUNI and bicycling, providing a greenbelt and expanded
18 open space and recreation areas, and improving water quality in Lake Merced; and

19 WHEREAS, regardless of the above the project may nonetheless have an as of yet
20 undetermined impact on the community; and,

21 WHEREAS, Land use and planning policies governing State owned land differ from
22 those of the City and therefore the project is not subject to local controls and the Planning
23 Department and Board of Supervisors will not have the opportunity for formal review; now,
24 therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the San Francisco Planning Director
2 to monitor the development plans and processes of the San Francisco State University
3 Master Plan; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors strongly urges the leadership
5 of San Francisco State University to include the Planning Director in its regular briefings and
6 to provide regular updates to the Planning Director and the Board of Supervisors throughout
7 this comprehensive process.
