URGING GOVERNOR GRAY DAVIS TO SUPPORT THE CALIFORNIA CASH ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR IMMIGRANTS (CAPI) AND THE CALIFORNIA FOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (CFAP) AND TO EXPAND BOTH PROGRAMS TO NEW IMMIGRANTS.

WHEREAS, Federal welfare reform resulted in the denial of SSI benefits to many elderly and disabled immigrants; and,

WHEREAS, In response to federal welfare reform, California created the CAPI and CFAP programs to replace federal food stamp and SSI benefits; and,

WHEREAS, The CAPI program provides benefits to certain immigrants who cannot receive federal SSI due to their immigration status including: legal permanent residents who entered the U.S. before August 22, 1996 who are now aged and legal permanent residents who entered after August 22, 1996 who are now aged or disabled and whose immigration sponsor is deceased, abusive, or disabled; and,

WHEREAS, the CAPI and CFAP programs are the only source of federal or state cash assistance for these elderly and disabled immigrants; and,

WHEREAS, The CAPI program and the CFAP program are set to sunset in July of 2000; and,

WHEREAS, Elimination of the CAPI program in July 2000 will deprive over 1,500 elderly and disabled San Francisco residents of all federal or state SSI benefits;

WHEREAS, Governor Gray Davis has yet to indicate his support for the CAPI and CFAP programs; and

WHEREAS, The Governor plans to finalize his budget by this Friday, June 11 so a resolution in support of the CAPI and CFAP programs needs to be passed before then; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco urges Governor Davis to continue funding for the CAPI program and to expand the CAPI and CFAP program to new immigrants; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to Governor Davis and to San Francisco's representatives in the State Senate and Assembly.
