

1 [Large Capacity Ammunition Magazine Import Ban of 1999]
2 URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO APPROVE S.594 AND H.R.1037
3 BANNING THE IMPORTATION OF HIGH-CAPACITY AMMUNITION CLIPS INTO THE
4 UNITED STATES.

6 WHEREAS, Federal assault weapons legislation enacted in 1994 prohibits the
7 domestic manufacture of high-capacity ammunition clips, drums, and strips that hold more
8 than ten bullets; and,

9 WHEREAS, There is currently no prohibition against the importation of high-capacity
10 ammunition clips by foreign manufacturers; and,

11 WHEREAS, According to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms, since the
12 1994 assault weapons legislation, millions of high-capacity clips have been approved for
13 importation; and,

14 WHEREAS, S.594 and H.R. 1037, the Large Capacity Ammunition Magazine Import
15 Ban of 1999, would ban the importation of large capacity ammunition feeding devices and
16 extend the ban on transferring such devices to those that were manufactured before the ban
17 becomes law; and,

18 WHEREAS, S.594 and H.R. 1037 are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
19 in File No. 990547 ; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
21 endorses S.594 and H.R. 1037 and urges the United States Congress to approve this
22 legislation; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the
24 Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from California in Congress.
