URGING THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS TO APPROVE S.594 AND H.R.1037
BANNING THE IMPORTATION OF HIGH-CAPACITY AMMUNITION CLIPS INTO THE UNITED STATES.

WHEREAS, Federal assault weapons legislation enacted in 1994 prohibits the domestic manufacture of high-capacity ammunition clips, drums, and strips that hold more than ten bullets; and,

WHEREAS, There is currently no prohibition against the importation of high-capacity ammunition clips by foreign manufacturers; and,

WHEREAS, According to the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms, since the 1994 assault weapons legislation, millions of high-capacity clips have been approved for importation; and,

WHEREAS, S.594 and H.R. 1037, the Large Capacity Ammunition Magazine Import Ban of 1999, would ban the importation of large capacity ammunition feeding devices and extend the ban on transferring such devices to those that were manufactured before the ban becomes law; and,

WHEREAS, S.594 and H.R. 1037 are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ______; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco endorses S.594 and H.R. 1037 and urges the United States Congress to approve this legislation; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the Mayor, with a request that he transmit copies to the delegation from California in Congress.
