13	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
14	
15	Section 1. The Administrative Code is hereby amended by revising Section 2A.240, to
16	read as follows:

18	SEC. 2A.240. SMALL BUSINESS COMMISSION; POWERS AND DUTIES.
19	(a) The Small Business Commission shall:
20	1. Formulate and evaluate goals, objectives, plans, and programs and set policies
21	for the City regarding small businesses, consistent with any overall objectives established by
22	the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors through the adoption of legislation, in order to
23	promote the economic health of the small business community in San Francisco, its
24	employees, and its customers;

- Develop and keep current an annual statement of purpose outlining its areas of jurisdiction, authorities, purpose and goals, subject to review and approval by the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors;
 Recommend to the Mayor for submission to the Board of Supervisors rates, fees and similar charges with respect to appropriate items coming within its jurisdiction;
 Prepare and recommend to the Mayor an annual budget for the Commission's activities:
 - 5. Oversee grants and programs concerning and benefiting small businesses and neighborhood business districts;
 - 6. Review all legislation affecting small businesses and make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors;
 - 7. Declare one month out of the year Small Business Month;
 - 8. Establish an application and selection process to provide recognition during at least one public event during Small Business Month to outstanding local small businesses that contribute to the vitality of San Francisco. Solicitation for honorees shall come from the Mayor, individual members of the Board of Supervisors, individual members of the Commission, and the general public; During Small Business Month, coordinate activities to encourage the general public to support San Francisco small businesses;
 - 9. Review rules and regulations adopted by City departments that affect small businesses and recommend modifications that would promote the health of small businesses;
 - 10. Collect and analyze information about the small business economy in San Francisco, as well as conduct investigations under its power of inquiry into any aspect of governmental operations affecting small businesses, including holding hearings and taking testimony, and make recommendations to the Mayor or the Board of Supervisors; and

1	11. The Commission may adopt such rules and regulations consistent with the
2	provisions of this Section as are necessary for the conduct of its business. Such rules and
3	regulations shall be available for public review and comment for 10 days before they are
4	finally adopted by the Commission.
5	
6	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
7	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
8	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
9	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
10	
11	Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
12	intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
13	numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
14	Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
15	additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
16	the official title of the ordinance.

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to revise the duties of the Small Business Commission by replacing the duty to coordinate an application and selection process to recognize outstanding contributions by small businesses during Small Business Month with a duty to coordinate activities to encourage the general public to support San Francisco small businesses during Small Business Month.

Existing Law

Currently, the Administrative Code requires the Small Business Commission to perform a number of duties, including a duty to establish an application and selection process to provide recognition during at least one public event during Small Business Month to outstanding local small businesses that contribute to the vitality of San Francisco.

Amendments to Current Law

The proposed ordinance would replace the duty to coordinate an application and selection process for small business recognition with a duty to coordinate activities to encourage general public support for Small businesses during Small Business Month.
