1	[Authorizing the Office of Contract Administration to amend its contract with
2	Micromenders/GC Micro to exceed \$10 million.]
3	Resolution authorizing the Office of Contract Administration to enter into the Fourth
4	Amendment between the City and Micromenders/GC Micro (part of the Computer Store
5	procurement vehicle), in which the amendment shall increase the contract's anticipated
6	expenditures to over \$10 million.
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8	WHEREAS, the Committee on Information Technology and the Office of Contract
9	Administration, by competitive bidding, developed the Computer Store procurement method for
10	the purchase of products and services related to Information Technology; and
11	WHEREAS, the original contract with Micromenders/GC Micro was dated
12	January 1, 2004; had a term of three years, through December 31, 2006; and
13	WHEREAS, the contract has been amended thrice, by the First Amendment, dated
14	July 1, 2004; the Second Amendment, dated February 11, 2005; and the Third Amendment, dated
15	December 29, 2006, which extended the contract through December 31, 2007; and,
16	WHEREAS, the original contract's not-to-exceed amount for compensation (found in
17	Section 5 of the contract) was \$9,999,999, and that said amount has not been changed by any prior
18	Amendment; and,
19	WHEREAS, the Office of Contract Administration estimates that the money projected to be
20	spent with Micromenders/GC Micro could reach the contract's not-to-exceed compensation
21	amount in the reasonably near future; and
22	WHEREAS, Charter section 9.118, "Contract and Lease Limitations," subsection (b),
23	requires Board of Supervisors approval of any contract estimated to exceed \$10 million in
24	expenditures; now, therefore, be it
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1	RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Office of Contract
2	Administration enter into Amendment 4 to the contract with Micromenders/GC Micro; and be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, that said Amendment shall increase the not-to-exceed
4	compensation amount for the contract with Micromenders/GC Micro from \$9,999,999 to
5	\$13 million.
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
