WHEREAS, The Board, in accordance with Planning Code Section 306.4(d) may, by resolution, extend the prescribed time within which the Planning Commission is to render its decision on proposed amendments to the Planning Code initiated by the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, The Board deems it appropriate in this instance to grant to the Planning Commission an additional 90 days to review the proposed ordinance and render its decision; now, therefore, be it
