[Authorizing consulting firm to examine confidential State Board of Equalization tax records.]

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco has entered into a contract with the firm of Bay Area Economics (BAE) to perform consulting services related to determining allowable recovery of City service expenditures from public trust revenues held in the Harbor Revenue fund (Charter Section B6.406); and

WHEREAS, Section 7056 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code allows the governing body of a city and county by resolution to authorize persons other than officers and employees to examine confidential sales or transaction and use tax records of the State Board of Equalization on behalf of the City and County, subject to certain conditions; now, therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco certifies that BAE: (1) has an existing contract with the City and County to examine those sales or transaction and use tax records; (2) is required by that contract to disclose information contained in, or derived from, those sales or transaction and use tax records only to an officer or employee of the City and County who is authorized under Section 7056 of the California Revenue and Taxation Code to examine the information; (3) is prohibited by that contract from performing consulting services for a retailer during the term of that contract; and (4) is prohibited by that contract from retaining the information contained in, or derived from, those sales or transaction and use tax records after the contract has expired; and be it
