**SUBJECT: Retroactive Accept and Expend Legislation and Contract  
Approval with California State Parks for \$25,000,000 in  
Specified Grant funding for the India Basin 900 Innes Project.**

The San Francisco Recreation and Park Department (RPD) is seeking the Board of Supervisors retroactive approval to accept and expend a Specified Grant in the amount of for \$25,000,000 and authorization for the RPD to execute a grant contract with the California Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) for the India Basin 900 Innes Project.

The retroactive nature of this legislation is due to the DPR's policy to back date grant contracts to the beginning of the fiscal year that grant funding is appropriated in the State Budget. The India Basin 900 Innes Specified Grant was appropriated in Fiscal Year 2021-2022.

The Grant Contract period is five years, starting July 1, 2021, and ending on June 30, 2026.

No grant funds have been expended and the grant contract has not been executed.
