2 AMENDING PART I, CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE VIII-A OF THE SAN FRANCISCO MUNICIPAL
3 CODE (ADMINISTRATIVE CODE), BY AMENDING SECTIONS 16.121-2, 16.121-4 AND
4 16.121-5, TO DESIGNATE THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AS THE CHAIR OF THE CENTRAL
5 SAFETY COMMITTEE AND COORDINATOR OF THE ACCIDENT PREVENTION
6 PROGRAM, IN PLACE OF THE DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES.

7 Note: Additions or substitutions are underlined;
8 deletions are in ((double parentheses)).

9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

11 Section 1. Chapter 16 of the San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by
12 amending Sections 16.121-2 and 16.121-4, to read as follows:

14 **SEC. 16.121-2. CENTRAL SAFETY COMMITTEE; MEMBERS; PROCEDURE.**

15 A Central Safety Committee is hereby established consisting of the City Administrator,
16 who shall be chair, the Director of Administrative Services, ((who shall be chair,)) the Chief of
17 Police, the Chief of the Fire Department, the General Manager of the Park and Recreation
18 Department, the Manager of Utilities, the General Manager, Personnel, the President of the
19 Retirement Board, and the County Superintendent of Schools. It shall be the duty of each of
20 these designated officers to serve on the Central Safety Committee, except that any member
21 of the Committee may deputize in writing filed with the Committee any member of his or her
22 office or department to serve in his or her place on the Committee for such period or in such
23 meeting as he or she may desire. The Committee shall be in the office of the City
24 Administrator ((Director of Administrative Services)) and shall meet in his or her office. Neither
25 the members of the Committee nor the members of their offices or departments deputized to

1 serve in their places at any time shall receive any compensation as such members or acting
2 members for their services on the Committee.

3
4 **SEC. 16.121-4. CITY ADMINISTRATOR ((DIRECTOR OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES));**
5 **POWERS AND DUTIES.**

6 The City Administrator ((Director of Administrative Services)) shall act as coordinator of
7 the Accident Prevention Program under the direction of the Central Safety Committee.

8
9 **SEC. 16.121-5. POWERS OF CITY AND COUNTY OFFICERS NOT DIVESTED.**

10 No provision of this Article shall be deemed or construed to grant any authority to, or
11 impose any duty upon, the Central Safety Committee or the City Administrator ((Director of
12 Administrative Services)) which is vested or imposed by general law or the Charter of the City
13 and County of San Francisco in or on any other officer, board, commission, department, or
14 employee of the City and County.


