3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Office of the District Attorney to accept and**  
4 **expend a grant in the amount of \$2,530,990.23 from the California Victim**  
5 **Compensation Board for a project, entitled “Joint Powers Agreement,” to assist**  
6 **victims and witnesses with compensation claims for the period July 1, 2021, through**  
7 **June 30, 2024.**

9 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, Office of the District Attorney  
10 desires to enter into an agreement with the California Victim Compensation Board in  
11 accordance with Government Section 13838 for the purpose of assisting victims and  
12 witnesses with compensation claims; and

13 WHEREAS, Funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant local funds that  
14 would, in the absence of California Victim Compensation Board Programs, be made available  
15 to support the assistance of victims and witnesses of crime; and

16 WHEREAS, All positions supported by these funds shall be coded “G” in the District  
17 Attorney’s budget; and

18 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an amendment to the Annual Salary Ordinance  
19 (ASO); and

20 WHEREAS, The grant budget does not include provision for indirect costs; now,  
21 therefore, be it

22 **RESOLVED**, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Office of the District  
23 Attorney to retroactively accept and expend, on behalf of the City and County of San  
24 Francisco, a grant from the California Victim Compensation Board to continue the Joint  
25 Powers Agreement in the amount of \$2,530,990.23 to assist victims of crime; and, be it
