

1 [Accept-Expend Grant – Visitacion Valley CRN]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of the District Attorney of the City and County**  
4 **of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$444,253**  
5 **from the Department of Justice, for a program entitled “San Francisco’s Visitacion**  
6 **Valley Community Response Network” for the period July 1, 2006 to December 31,**  
7 **2007.**

9 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco desires to establish a certain  
10 project designated the San Francisco’s Visitacion Valley Community Response Network  
11 (CRN) to be funded in part from funds made available from the Department of Justice, Office  
12 of Justice Programs (hereafter “DOJ”); and,

13 WHEREAS, the grant does not require an ASO amendment; and,

14 WHEREAS, The terms of the grant prohibit inclusion of indirect costs in the grant  
15 budget, now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the District Attorney of  
17 the City and County of San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend funds from DOJ for  
18 the purposes of its San Francisco’s Visitacion Valley Community Response Network; and,  
19 be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of  
21 indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

22 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized to execute on behalf of  
23 the City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Award Agreements for San  
24 Francisco’s Visitacion Valley Community Response Network purposes, including any  
25 extensions, augmentations or amendments thereof; and be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the District Attorney is authorized and empowered to  
2 execute, deliver and perform, in the name of the City and County of San Francisco, all  
3 applications, contracts, agreements, amendments and payment requests necessary for the  
4 purpose of securing DOJ grant funds and to implement and carry out the purposes specified  
5 in the applicable grant application; and be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED, That any liability arising out of the performance of the Grant  
7 Award Agreement, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the  
8 grant recipient and the authorizing agency; and that the grant recipient and the authorizing  
9 agency will hold DOJ harmless from any claims that may arise from the use of grant funds;  
10 be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to  
12 supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
