WHEREAS, It is critical for City departments to play an integral and proactive role in the implementation of Chapter 12D through comprehensive input and participation in the Citywide Diversity Tracking System; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco requires each City Department, as stipulated in Chapter 12D.A.6.A(1) and 12D.A.18 (C) of San Francisco's Administrative Code, to submit a comprehensive strategic plan detailing allocation of resources related to the implementation of the Diversity Tracking System, an accompanying budget itemizing the funds required as well as a list of assigned staff.
