

1 [Allow the Department of Public Health to Accept and Execute California Department of  
2 Transportation Grants - Non-Infrastructure Transportation Projects]

3 **Resolution authorizing the Department of Public Health to receive Federal and State**  
4 **Funding for certain Non-Infrastructure Transportation Projects through the California**  
5 **Department of Transportation, and to delegate authorization to execute agreements**  
6 **and any amendments to the Director of the Department of Public Health.**

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8 WHEREAS, San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) has a vested interest  
9 to promote both safe and active transportation in order to improve health outcomes in San  
10 Francisco such as reducing traffic injuries, increasing physical activity, reducing obesity, and  
11 improving air quality; and

12 WHEREAS, SFDPH is the co-chair of the SF Vision Zero Task Force, a City initiative to  
13 eliminate traffic deaths by 2024; and

14 WHEREAS, SFDPH has also managed the San Francisco Safe Routes to School  
15 (SRTS) Program since 2009, a program to promote safe and active walking and biking to and  
16 from school for schoolchildren and their families; and

17 WHEREAS, SFDPH has received grant funding from the California Department of  
18 Transportation for the SRTS Program since its inception; and

19 WHEREAS, SFDPH is eligible to receive Federal and State funding for certain  
20 Transportation Projects, through the California Department of Transportation; now, therefore,  
21 be it

22 RESOLVED, All Master Agreements, Program Supplemental Agreements, Fund  
23 Exchange Agreements and/or Fund Transfer Agreements need to be executed with the  
24 California Department of Transportation before such funds could be claimed; and, be it

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1           FURTHER RESOLVED, The City and County of San Francisco wishes to delegate  
2 authorization to execute these agreements and any amendments thereto to the Director of the  
3 San Francisco Department of Public Health to be authorized to execute all Master  
4 Agreements, Program Supplemental Agreements, Fund Exchange Agreements, Fund  
5 Transfer Agreements, and any amendments thereto with California Department of  
6 Transportation.
