21	program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

23	amount of \$18,813 from BACR; and, be it
24	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
25	indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it
