

1 [Changing Official Width of Sidewalk]

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3 **Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 1061 entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks"**
4 **by adding thereto Section 1557 to change the official sidewalk width on the on the**
5 **northwest side of Treat Avenue between Alameda and Florida Streets; making findings**
6 **pursuant to the General Plan and Planning Code Section 101.1; and requiring**
7 **relocation, modification, or both of facilities affected by the sidewalk width changes.**

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9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. The San Francisco Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and
11 incorporates by reference herein as though fully set forth the findings made by the Planning
12 Department in its letter dated October 4, 2002, which stated that the actions contemplated
13 herein are consistent with the General Plan and is consistent with the Eight Priority Policies of
14 City Planning Code Section 101.1.

15 Section 2. In accordance with the Department of Public Works Order No. 173,795, a
16 copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 021828, Board of
17 Supervisors Ordinance No. 1061, entitled "Regulating the Width of Sidewalks," a copy of
18 which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors Book of General Ordinances, in effect May
19 11, 1910, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

20 Section 1557 . The width of sidewalks on the northwest side of Treat Avenue between
21 Alameda and Florida Streets, shall be as shown on Department of Public Works drawing Q-20-545, a
22 copy of which is in the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors File No. 021828.

23 Section 3. SLS Associates, Inc., the project sponsor who proposes to undertake the
24 sidewalk construction to implement the sidewalk width changes, is required to make
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1 arrangements with public utilities and City Departments concerning relocation, modification,
 2 or both of facilities in the affected sidewalk and street areas. Any necessary relocation,
 3 modification, or both of such facilities shall be at no cost to the City and County of San
 4 Francisco.
